#### **Decieved**

**Proverbs 14:8** The wisdom of the prudent is to give thought to their ways, but the folly of fools is deception. (They are often deceived)

### Passive-aggressive stubbornness.

**Proverbs 10:18** He who conceals his hatred has lying lips, and whoever spreads slander is a fool.

Act out with great anger, hot-tempered, bordering on rage.

**Proverbs 29:11** A fool gives full vent to his anger, but a wise man keeps himself under control.

**Proverbs 14:16** A wise man fears the LORD and shuns evil, but a **fool** is **hotheaded** and reckless.

The next two categories cross the line and enter into "Wickedness."

### **Summary:**

This is a much more serious category of foolishness.

He unashamedly pursues pleasures and his sinful boldness is frightening.

Selfish appetites remain unchanged. He cares little about God's opinion or advice.

Self-inflicted wounds ultimately consume them.

**Proverbs 23:9** Do not speak to a fool, for he will scorn the wisdom of your words.

Proverbs 26:4 Do not answer a fool according this folly, or you will be like him yourself.

Proverbs 26:5 Answer a fool according to his folly, or he will be wise in his own eyes.
